Job Description

Key Duties

- To perform maintenance and upkeep tasks on various facilities which includes air-conditioners, plumbing/piping/sanitary, all electrical system related auxiliaries, water reticulation and sewerage treatment plants.
- To perform basic electrical wiring tasks and upkeep tasks on ELV and safety related systems such as fire alarm panel, CCTV, barrier and auto gates, audio visual system, etc;
- To recommend appropriate tools to perform maintenance, inspection on ELV facilities and utilise prepared ELV system checklist for monitoring purposes;
- To perform planned preventive maintenance tasks on ELV system/facilities as planned;
- To perform basic civil, structural tasks and assist in maintenance of all KTJ's swimming pools (ensuring that the salt, PH and chlorine levels are monitored).
- To troubleshoot and repair electrical household apparatus effectively.
- To inspect facilities periodically to identify problems and necessary maintenance.
- To ensure works are carried out in accordance with the specifications and approved procedures.
- To oversee repairs and ensure that work is completed on time.
- To ensure adherence to quality standards and health and safety regulations.
- To perform any other duties assigned by his superior management.
- To be on standby by rotation after working hours to attend to any emergency situation in KTJ.
- To work additional approved hours if required and will be compensated accordingly.
