1. Customer Service

- Serve students, staff, and visitors in a friendly and professional manner;

- Explain menu items in detail and provide recommendations based on customer preferences;
- Handle customer payments, operate the POS (Point of Sale) system, and manage transactions accurately;
- Respond to customer inquiries, concerns, and feedback in a polite and effective manner.

2. Beverage & Light Food Preparation

- Assist in preparing a variety of beverages, including coffee, tea, and smoothies, in accordance with established recipes and school standards;
- Prepare and arrange light food items (e.g., sandwiches, muffins) for display and service;
- Ensure all beverages and food items meet quality and presentation standards.

3. Cleaning & Maintenance

- Maintain a clean and organized work environment, including counters, coffee machines, and food preparation areas;
- Take responsibility for the care of coffee machines, grinders, and other equipment;
- Perform deep cleaning and routine maintenance of machines;

- Regularly inspect and clean equipment to ensure proper working condition;
