

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Requirements

All **new** students joining KTJ as of August 2025 must have a touch screen device with keyboard and stylus. As of August 2025, students who are in Form 1 to Form 4 and Lower Sixth must have a touchscreen device with keyboard and stylus.

BYOD requirement rationale:

- It reduces the need for students to carry vast amounts of books and paper.
- Students can annotate electronic books and handouts.
- Students can write on PDF documents such as past exam papers, which reduces the need for printing and allows students to easily share their work with teachers online.
- Students can work in real-time on group projects, such as assessments, literature and project work, using handwritten annotations.
- Touchscreen devices improve accessibility and inclusivity.
- Touchscreen devices are more effective at zooming in and out of documents, making it easier for students to see the detail in images, read documents, etc.
- Touchscreen devices provide the ability to interact with your work using a stylus or fingers, bringing a level of precision that is hard to achieve with a laptop.
- Teachers are using Microsoft Whiteboards and Microsoft OneNote devices as teaching tools, providing an improved experience for students with touchscreen devices.











Frequently asked questions:

Can my child have more than one device?

Students are welcome to have a laptop device alongside their touchscreen device should they wish to do so. But it is not a requirement to have more than one device. The device all students will need to have (following the implementation of the plan above) is a touch screen device with a stylus and keyboard as a priority. Some students already have laptops alongside a touchscreen device with a stylus.

What if my child's device accidentally breaks?

As advised above, parents are strongly advised to ensure that the device is covered under insurance / warranty. We also advise a strong case and screen protector.

Will my child be using this device at all times? Is this the end of using a pen and paper?

No. Teachers will still use various resources in lessons, combining the traditional with the technology available. Writing in exercise books, designing posters, annotating, drawing graphs, and producing artwork will still be taught in class.

Can my child have a power bank with their device?

Yes, they can have a power bank. Although this is not a requirement. However, it is an expectation that students arrive at school with a fully charged device each day.
