We are seeking a highly motivated nurse to join us. The School Nurse works as part of our Health Centre team to help maintain and promote the good health and well-being of all members of our community in order to support teaching and learning at the School.

Job Description

At KTJ, we believe with a commitment to professional development, we offer opportunities for growth in a warm and welcoming student-centred environment. Join us and become part of a community that values creativity, embraces new ideas and encourages progressive thinking.

Key Duties

- To work as a team with the School Doctor, other Nurses and Klinik Staff;
- To assist the School Doctor in providing healthcare, screening and emergency care to students and staff;
- To assist the School Doctor in developing care plans based on assessment and interventions, and with the identification of outcomes and evaluation of care;
- To assist the School Doctor in monitoring immunisations, managing communicable diseases, and risk assessing the school environment to reduce the likelihood of injuries or harm;
- To oversee and implement infection control measures as set out by the School Doctor;
- To actively participate in school safety planning and to provide input for SOPs;
- To oversee medication administration, documenting patients' history, symptoms and treatment, and ensuring patient information is easy to access and retrieve;
- To support the School Doctor with the creation of healthcare procedures and plans;
- To report any concerns/medical errors immediately to the School Doctor or Safeguarding Team or the Principal, as appropriate;



- To assist with the maintenance of the medication inventory and to ensure medication is accurately recorded, in date and administered appropriately;
- To provide health-related education for both students and staff in individual and group settings;
- To follow and adhere to all KTJ Klinik policies and procedures, and to instructions given by the School Doctor;
- To provide first aid as required;
- To carry out any other reasonable duties as instructed by management.

Personal characteristics and skills

- Strong team member, who acts professionally and who builds and promotes trust and openness;
- Strong interpersonal skills, including the ability to manage patients effectively and sensitively;
- A clear understanding of the need for patient confidentiality and adherence to data protection protocols;

- The ability to dispense medication as prescribed;
